Post Operative Instructions

BREAST SURGERY

Your next appointment is:

- Depending on your procedure, you may have been given stronger pain relief medication such as Panadeine Forte. If not, regular Panadol should be adequate.
- Common sense restriction of physical activity in the early post-operative phase is necessary to avoid potential pain, bleeding or wound disruption.
- Avoid heavy lifting or straining
- You may experience minor bleeding and wound seeping. This is normal. If bleeding persists, firm pressure for 5-10 minutes should stop it.
- Hypafix (white tape) is used to support your surgical wound. This can be safely washed and will quickly dry. This will be changed at your one week post operative appointment and thereafter weekly at home.
